June marks the meteorological start of summer and for us in school it means the better weather allows us to do more and more outside learning. That is why June is geography fieldwork month. Fieldwork is a key element of the geography curriculum and this month each year group will be undertaking a different activity in the local area either around the school ground or in the surrounding roads.

We also have the majority of our school trips happening this half term. Below are several pictures from Year 5's excellent trip to Colchester Zoo yesterday which linked to their science topic. We had a teacher in from Kelvedon Hatch to see the good work we do and Miss Chambers visited St Martins to look at what happens in secondary school.
