#### **Headteacher Comment:**

We are very lucky at Larchwood to have a really engaged and supportive group of parents. This is especially true with the work for the fabulous Larchwood Primary Parents Association (LPPA). On Tuesday evening they held their AGM (see photo below) and once again it was another successful year.

In the last year they have spent over £14,000 on our children including items such as the book bags Reception are given, the playground markings and the leavers hoodies that Year 6 receive. Last year they raised a fantastic £9,345 which is not far off the record for a year.

One of the main aims of the LPPA is that the events they hold are affordable and inclusive so that all children can take part. There are lots of exciting events planned for the year, some of which are listed on the diary dates below. The first is a pumpkin carving competition over half term, before we get into the busy Christmas period. I can also confirm that the hugely successful colour run that took place in 2023 will return for summer 2025 – I will be taking names of anyone who gets me this time!
