Headteacher Comment:

I hope everyone had a really enjoyable two-week half term. There are many benefits to coming to Larchwood and at this time of year that longer break is definitely one of them. After an eight-week half term everyone needed a good rest to recharge and spend time with family.

The longer break was an excellent opportunity for the different building teams to complete some of their major works and the school was completely shut over the two weeks. All 46 fire doors have been replaced, the electrical wiring, lighting and ceilings in the Year 6 end of the school were replaced, and the biggest bit of work was the switch over to the new heating and water distribution system. It was a big relief to come and check on the site at the end of last week to find the school toasty warm and hot water in all the sinks. Well done to all the teams, including Larchwood staff, for working so hard and getting the school back up and running for Monday morning.

Since we have been back plenty has been going on. We welcomed our new Pabulum chef, Mark, on Monday and I can confirm that the roast dinner I had on Wednesday with Year 4 was delicious. In regards to learning, each class has started a new book as their English focus, new topics have been started in foundation subjects. On Wednesday, Key Stage 2 students attended an assembly led by Nicola Doubleday, the Essex Cyber Prevent and Protect officer, where they learned about the Computer Misuse Act and online safety. Nicola introduced various pieces of legislation, explained the potential consequences of cybercrimes, and emphasised the importance of staying safe online and protecting things like passwords (photo below).

Finally, the Tag Rugby team had their first match after school on Thursday against Woodlands Hutton Manor where they played excellently and demonstrated all the Larchwood values, despite not quite winning. Thank you to all the parents who helped with lifts and came to support (photo below).
