We are proposing to make one change to our Admission Arrangements for Academic Year 2026/27. It will revert to previous Waiting List wording, meaning that the Waiting Lists will only remain open until the end of the academic year. If parents/carers wish for their child to remain on the Waiting List, they must contact Larchwood Primary School to confirm. Without such confirmation, the child's name will be removed at the end of the academic year.

The statutory consultation period is open for six weeks from Thursday 17 October and will close on Thursday 12 December 2024.
